The **Environmental Technology** program will be expanded to include both waste water and potable water through a redesigned curriculum that supports stackable KDHE certificates and an AAS degree. The program will utilize interactive distance delivery of lectures and on-site training at treatment facilities through the use of Job Specific Instruction (JSI). In addition, short-term workshops on specific topics will be offered for Potable Water and Wastewater operators to meet the KDHE requirement for continuing education. This new and improved program is funded by the U. S. Department of Labor through the TRAC - 7 grant program.
