Tier 3

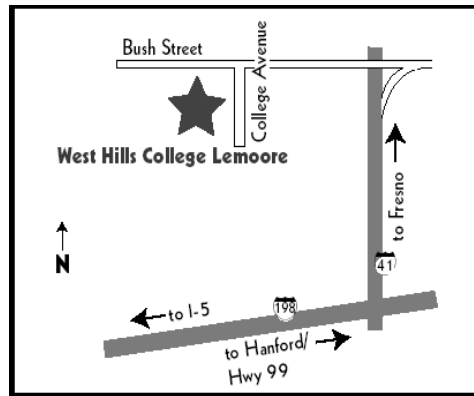

Application Process

- ❖ At least 18 years of age
- ❖ High school diploma or GED
- ❖ Minimum GPA 2.5
- ❖ Completion of Prerequisites with a minimum of C or better in each course
- ❖ Prerequisite-nursing courses cannot be repeated more than once
- ❖ Prerequisites require a GPA of 2.5 overall
- ❖ Current License - Psychiatric Technician
- ❖ Official transcripts of completed college courses, catalog description if class not taken at West Hills College
- ❖ Criminal background clearance
- ❖ Health screen clearance
- ❖ Possession of health-care provider CPR card
- ❖ Minimum of 62% on ATI-TEAS Test (Assessment Technologies Institute of Essential Academic Skills)
- ❖ Meet the national standard score on the ATI Pharmacology and ATI Nursing Fundamentals exam
- ❖ Pass a skills competency test
