JASSI (Jeffco Aspiring Student Scholar Institute) is an intensive 6-week program designed to help beginning Jefferson College students increase their foundational skills in an effort to improve COMPASS test scores. Improved COMPASS scores may allow students to place into higher level courses thus saving a student time and money on his/her college career path.

Students will be allowed to COMPASS test again without additional fees at the completion of the JASSI program. JASSI completers will also be given assistance with course registration. JASSI will use additional program materials to increase each student's self-knowledge so as to further enhance achieving one's life and college goals.
