Here is a check list of items and documents that are required to be submitted BEFORE A STUDENT IS PERMITTED TO START THE CLINICAL COURSE.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Copy of current Certified Nurse Aide License
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Current CPR Card – BLS for Health Care Providers accredited through either the American Heart Association or American Red Cross
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Statement of Health Care Provider that includes a TB Test, Flu Shot and all listed vaccinations. [Statement of Health Care Provider](#) Form.

If you have a current medical background check (within the past semester) please contact \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_-\_\_\_-\_\_\_\_ to verify eligibility. If you have any Disqualifying Criminal Offenses on your background check, you cannot remain in the program.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Drug Screen – Contact \_\_\_ at Wiz Quiz to schedule a drug test, \_\_\_-\_\_\_-\_\_\_\_. The drug test is \$25.00 and if it is diluted it will be \$15.00 to take it over. Call and schedule at least a week before the first day of the clinical. It will take 24-48 hours for the results, which you need to request the results be sent to Red Rocks Community College

(Although possession and use of marijuana for certain medical conditions consistent with the requirements of the Colorado Constitution is no longer a crime in the State of Colorado, the possession and use of marijuana remain illegal under federal law. Consistent with federal law, including the Controlled Substances Act and the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act, the use and or possession of marijuana continues to be prohibited for students seeking admission or enrolled in a health program at Red Rocks Community College. Therefore a student with a drug screening showing positive for use of marijuana is ineligible for admission and or continuance in the program).
