What is Prior Learning Assessment (PLA)?

PLA is a form of measuring what you have already learned OUTSIDE the classroom environment and using that knowledge to earn college credit.

What is the main goal of PLA?

To save you time (and money) by helping you earn a degree or certificate faster.

What kind of Learning does PLA evaluate?

Learning can take place in a variety of settings. PLA often evaluates learning acquired through workplace training, military service, independent study, professional certifications and civic activities.

How is credit earned?

Some of the most common methods used to earn credit are portfolio assessment and national or institutional examinations.
