Course Support of and Alignment to Learning Objectives	2	Lab materials are included in course modules and developed by the instructor. Labs are included with the appropriate learning module on the blackboard course website. Lab materials developed by the publisher were not submitted for review. Other course materials not included (e.g., lesson plans, lecture notes).
Sequencing of Course Content	2	Syllabi lists order of chapter coverage and online blackboard course website includes "Weekly Learning Modules" that include objectives that follow the syllabi and appear to be logically sequenced and related to expected learning outcomes.
Opportunities for Active Learning	2	There are weekly labs that are assumed to provide opportunities for active/applied learning. Most of the labs are part of the Microsoft course materials. There are four instructor developed labs included in the materials. Labs are included in weekly learning modules.
Opportunities for Formative Feedback to Students	2	Students receive weekly formative feedback on lab performance. Labs are submitted for each learning module under study and graded by the instructor. If students score less than 100%, the instructor provides feedback on what is missing or incorrect.
Summative Assessment of Learning	2	There is a mid-term and a final exam included in the materials. The instructor reports that the hands-on mid-term and final exams are all taken directly from labs the students completed over the course and they are aligned to the course objectives.
