Submit the following required documents before enrolling:

(These required documents will be explained during your meeting with the Coordinator.)

- Two separate Mantoux Tuberculosis skin test results taken within the past 12 months. You can obtain these tests at the Kansas City Health Department (816.513.6008), Free Health Clinic (816.753.5144), Truman Medical Centers (816.404.1000), doctors' offices and some pharmacies. Please call locations to check on times and cost.
- Family Care Safety Registry, which costs \$13. We recommend that you complete this online because online registrations are processed the same day they are received. Complete this registration at health.mo.gov/safety/fcsr. You will receive a letter in the mail from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. You must bring this letter to your enrollment appointment to enroll.

Additional class supplies and program costs not covered by the grant:

- Medical scrubs
- Manual blood pressure cuff
- Large three-ring binder

- Influenza vaccination
- Background check (\$39)
- 10-panel drug screen (\$32)
- Castle Branch (\$20)
