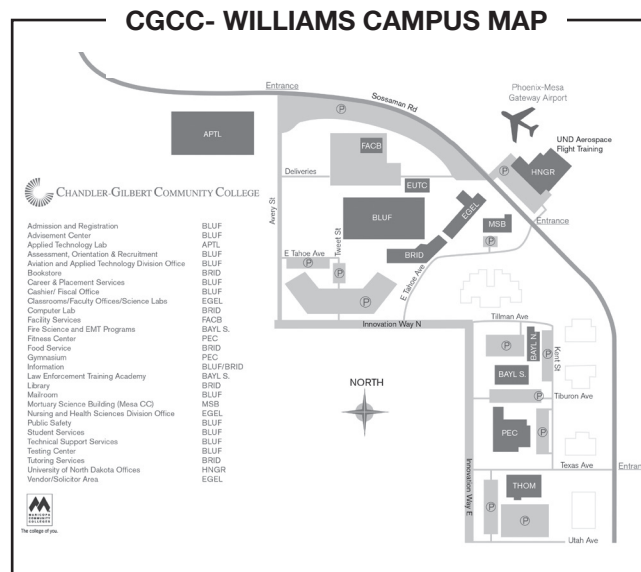

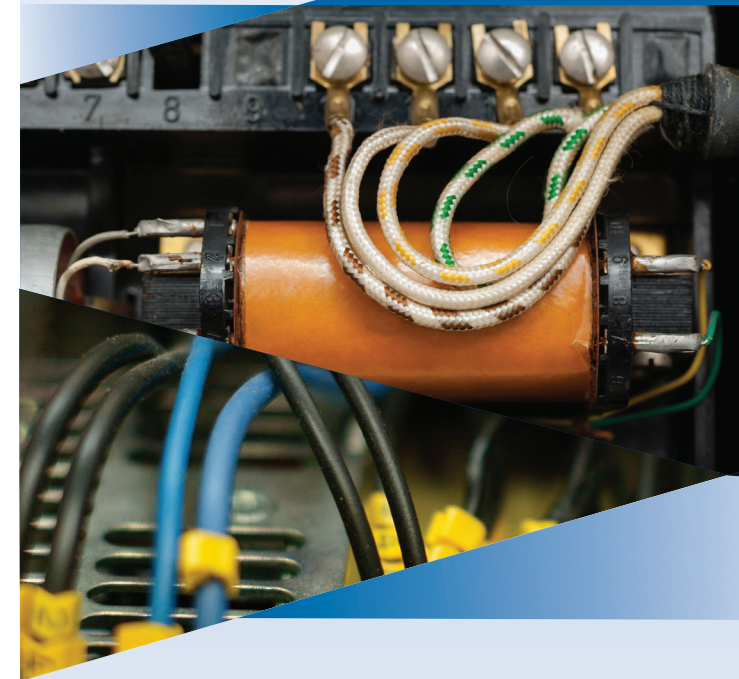


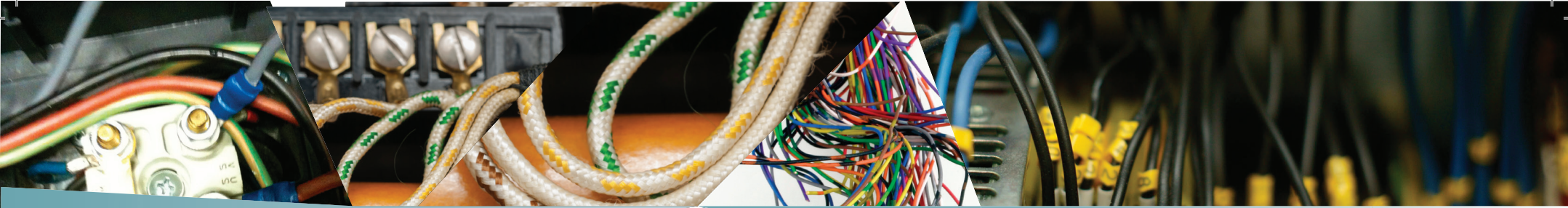

STEPS TO ENROLL:

1. You must take a pre-assessment test
 - a. Go online to mesacc.edu/azami/bootcamps, select the Boot Camp and then click on its pre-assessment test

- 2) If you pass the pre-assessment test, you are eligible to enroll in this Boot Camp, earning 4 college credits
- 3) If you don't pass the pre-assessment test and need more skills training, you can enroll in a one-semester program earning 8 credit hours to attain the certification.
