

Kellogg students are ready for new careers.

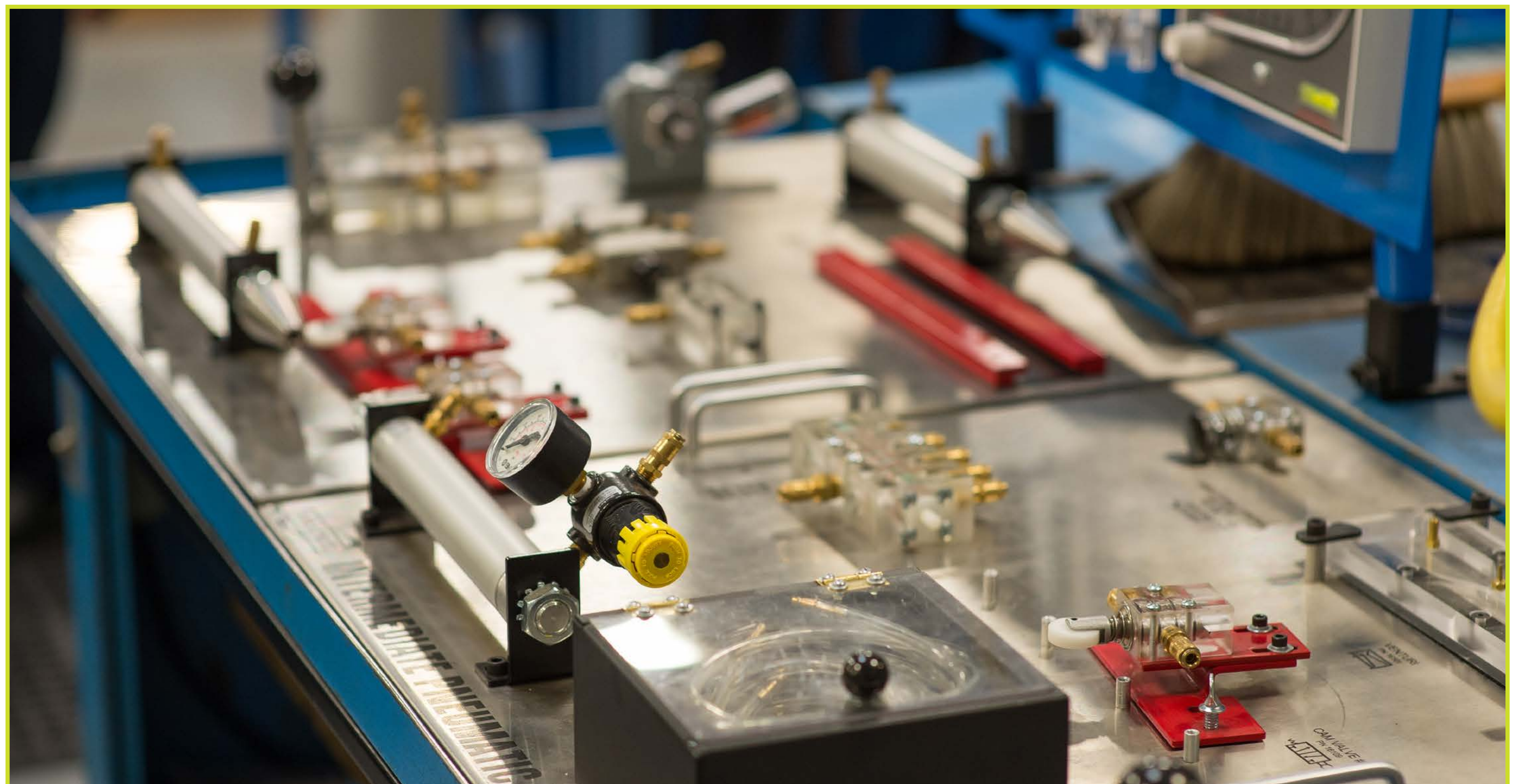
