Lake Michigan College students receive expert training.




"The instructors are experts in the field," said Chris Petty, **Lake Michigan Community College** robotics student.

"They worked in actual shops, and when they describe to you how to do some of the processes, they put it in the aspect of the employer – what the employer is going to be looking for and what their testing procedures are for specific products."

Eight Michigan community colleges formed the Michigan Coalition for Advanced Manufacturing (M-CAM) to enhance and create training programs in the in-demand areas of welding/fabrication, CNC machining, production operation and multi-skilled/mechatronics.
