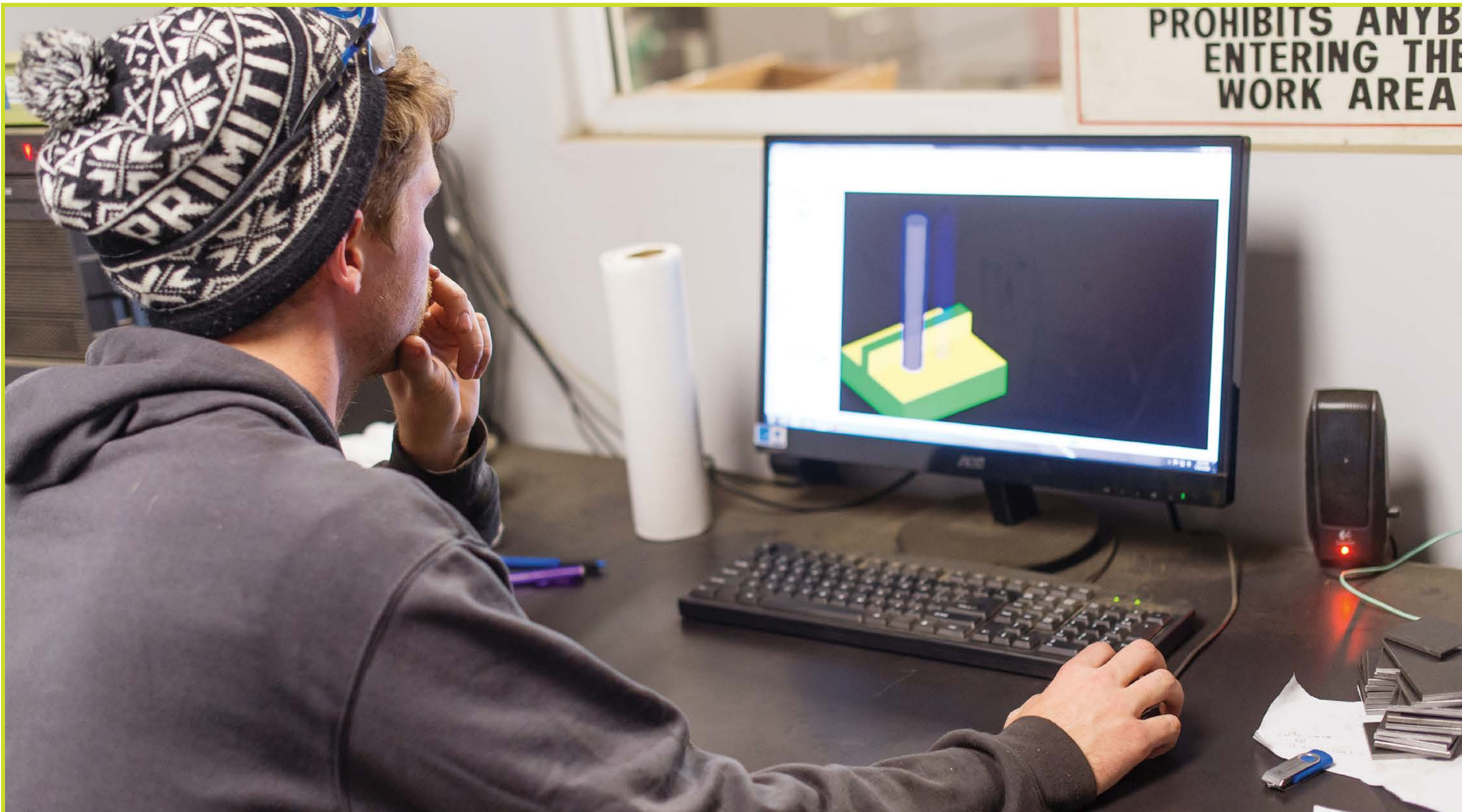


# Mott students get hands-on experience.
