Computer Support Technician

Computer Support Specialists in Minnesota made a median annual wage of \$43,347 in 2013. Computer Network Specialists in Minnesota made a median annual wage of \$59,950 in 2013.

Network Systems Administration

Network Systems Administrators in Minnesota made a median annual wage of \$74,568 in the first quarter of 2014.

Web Programmer

Web Developers in Minnesota made a median annual wage of \$68,328 in the first quarter of 2014.
