Yes, Explain: The various skills taught in this course cover a very broad base of art concepts, such as paint medium, all the way to cinematic renditions in the media. Various vocabulary, artists, and time periods are also covered giving a good foundation for any aspiring art professional. The skills taught in the art 102 course fulfill the goals to give students a general understanding of varying visual art pieces and art forms in the media and prepares students for the profession.
