

About CDL Training

The Commerical Driver's License (CDL) course is offered through Gateway Community & Technical College. The CDL course is designed for individuals with little or no commercial driving experience in preparation for an entry-level position in the trucking industry. Individuals will receive a Department of Transportation (DOT) physical; CDL learner's permit and endorsement preparation; DOT rules and regulations: log books; and training in map reading, trip planning, and vehicle operation. The course also includes the Class A road test.

Credentials

Upon completion of the course, individuals will receive a certificate as proof of successful completion.

Schedule

The full-time course is four weeks, four days a week. Classes start twice a month.

Requirements

Individuals must be able to read and write the English language, be at least 18 years of age, and be able to meet the Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) physical requirements and pass DOT drug test. Must have a valid Kentucky Drivers License.
