Week 9: The Problem Solving Essay

This week we will build on your reading from Week 8 and start your own problem solving essay. By now you should be familiar with the format and purpose of a problem solving essay. You should have also selected a topic for your own essay this week. Again, this topic should be drawn either from your workplace or your coursework in your field of study. However, note the following:

- As this is a problem with YOUR workplace or coursework, you can use the first person (I, me, my). Typically these are not allowed in academic writing.
- This must be a situation that can be solved.
- You are NOT to explain to me how you solved a problem, although you can use examples of how
 others solved similar problems as evidence to support your proposed solution(s). This must be a
 current problem that needs to be addressed.

This week your job is to read the assigned reading, participate in the classroom discussion, and submit the rough draft of your problem solving essay for peer review.

For the discussion, read the two articles about the "situation" of a stagnant economy and the proposed solutions offered. We will judge these against each other as well as against the criteria of the problem solving process.

In week 3 of the unit, we will have a final discussion forum and you will submit your final drafts.
