

Scoring Rubric for System Analysis Team Project

Teamwork (25 Points)	The team members worked well together to achieve the objectives. Each member contributed in a valuable way. (25-21 pts)	The team members worked well together most of the time with only a few occurrences of failure to collaborate. Team member contributed in some way. (20-16 pts)	Team member did not collaborate or communicate well. Team member did not contribute or do assigned work. (15-0 pts)
Supporting Material (20 Pts)	Deliverables contained relevant and valid information and include: Sample Database, Gant Chart, Data Flow Diagram, and Detailed Cost Analysis (20-16 pts)	Deliverables contained mostly relevant and valid information, however, one or two deliverables were missing. (15– 11 pts)	Deliverables were not relevant or valid. Three or more deliverables were missing. (10-0pts)
Report (30 pts)	Report was well organized and professional. Logic was clear and easy to follow. Sentences were free of grammar and typing errors. Report included summary and details. Included: Definition of problem, definition of the project, feasibility study, system requirements and team recommendation. (30-26 pts)	Report was mostly organized and somewhat professional. Logic was not clear in some areas. Only a few minor grammar and typing errors but they did not hinder the reader. One or two areas were lacking. (25-21 pts)	Report lacked organization, was messy and unprofessional. Logic did not make sense and did not related to the problem. Grammar and typing errors made it difficult to read. More than two areas were missing or lacking substance. (20-0 pts)
