Fastest Growing Occupations (Between 2012 - 2022)

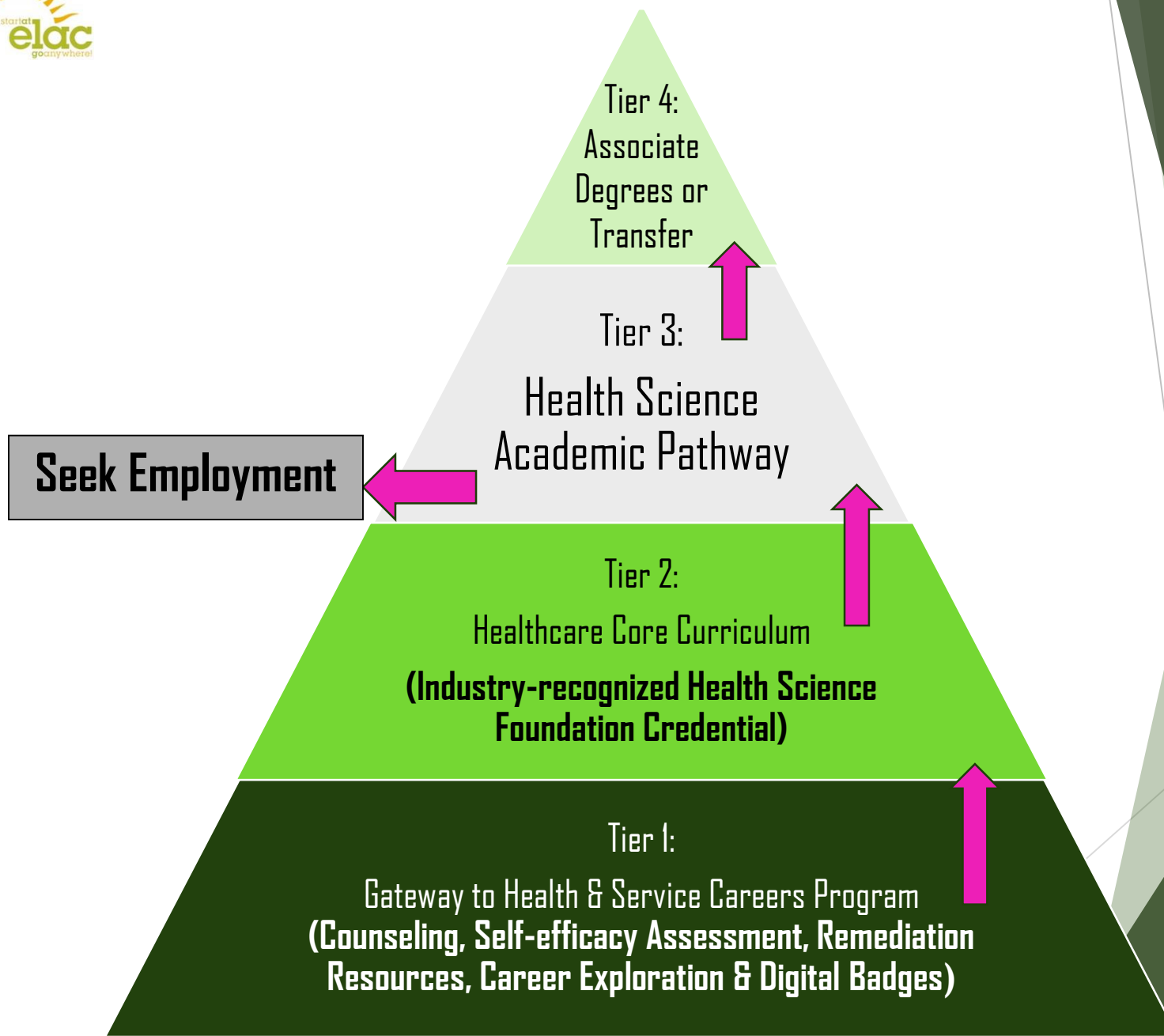

HLTHOCC 062

Skill Set for the Healthcare Professional



This course is an introduction to the concepts and skills that serve as a foundation for the health care professions. Topics include hygiene and safety, infection control, basic client monitoring and basic first aid, therapeutic communication and basic health documentation.

(2 units: Theory 18 hours/Lab 54 hours)



HLTHOCC 063

Basic Medical Terminology, Pathophysiology & Pharmacology for the Healthcare Professional



This basic medical language course will discuss common diseases and injuries and their pharmacological treatment using medical terminology in English and Spanish, when appropriate.

(2 units: Theory 36 hours)



Cultural and Legal Topics for Healthcare Professionals

This course provides an overview of the concepts of health and illness, cultural diversity and legal issues that affect the health care professional.

(1 unit: Theory 18 hours)

TIER 4: Associate Degree and Transfer

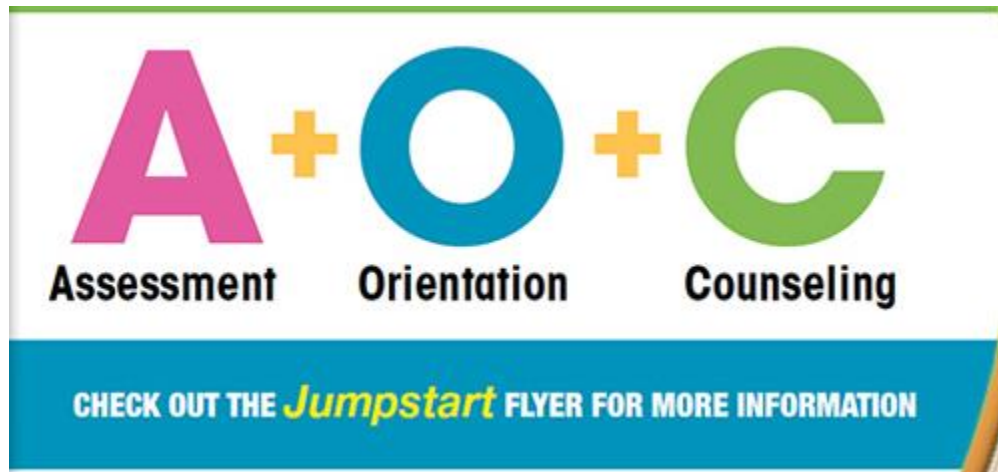
- Students complete academic requirements and achieve healthcare competencies that result in a degree and/or certificate.

Step 1:

Enroll in the College & complete Assessment, Orientation, and Counseling (AOC)





ELAC ENROLLMENT/STUDENT ID

- You must be enrolled in the college and have an active Student ID number to enroll in a class.
- Class enrollment will be processed using your Student ID number and an add slip during the “LAH3C Gateway Registration”.
- Your only cost will be the \$11.00 Student Health Fee which must be paid before end of semester.


