
Q7 Scenario - I developed a better understanding of medications.







Q8 Scenario - I had the opportunity to practice my clinical decision making skills.






Q9 Scenario - I am more confident in my ability to prioritize care and interventions.






Q10 Scenario - I am more confident in communicating with my patient.










