# SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT INDUSTRY RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATIONS

## Supply Chain Management Principles

Supply chain management is one of the fastest growing fields today. It is also expansive, as there are many functions and roles within it. This certification course is intended to train students in the basics of the supply chain and the supply chain's roles within organizations.

## Customer Service Operations

This certification course will provide students with an understanding of customer service and order management processes, techniques, and terminology that support order fulfillment and management.

## Inventory Management

This certification prepares students to understand inventory management controls and how inventory management interacts with warehousing, transportation, demand planning and other supply chain areas.

## Transportation Operations

This certification course is intended to train students in the basics of transportation operations as it relates to: modes of transportation, transportation technology, impact of transportation on the overall economy, and sustainability.

## Demand Planning

This certification course prepares students to understand the dynamics of forecasting and demand planning from requirements of the sales department and the translation of those requirements into the just-right orders for raw materials.

## Warehousing Operations

This certification course is intended to train students in the role of warehousing in the supply chain, facility configuration, storage and handling techniques, performance metrics, customer service considerations, and safety concerns across various types of distribution facilities.

## Manufacturing & Service Operations

Manufacturing and service operations are key components in the supply chain process once the raw or semi-finished materials arrive for production. This certification course prepares students to understand how manufacturing and service operation work together to control overall efficiency and expense in the conversion of materials into products and services.

## Supply Management & Procurement

This certification course prepares students to understand global sourcing and takes into account climate, political and social risks to an organization. Procurement must understand the economic and financial impact of fluctuations in availability, pricing and currency.
