The Advanced Manufacturing Apprenticeship Program was designed in partnership with regional manufacturers, Cuyahoga County Community College and Lorain County Community College to meet the need for a skilled workforce in Advanced Manufacturing: CNC, Industrial Maintenance, Machining, Tool & Die and Welding. The program allows for growth of the employee while meeting the in-demand needs of employers.
