The Manufacturing Readiness Program was designed by Lorain County Community College to meet the employer demand in Ohio for entry-level related workers. ***Tuition Assistance, Incentive Plans & Scholarships may be available for those who qualify!***

Entry-level positions, needed by manufacturers to increase growth and production, form a substantial portion of the available jobs in Ohio. Despite the increased demand, too few individuals are gaining the skills they need – foundational employability or technical skills – in order to begin working for Ohio manufacturers. The Manufacturing Readiness Program answers that need.
