



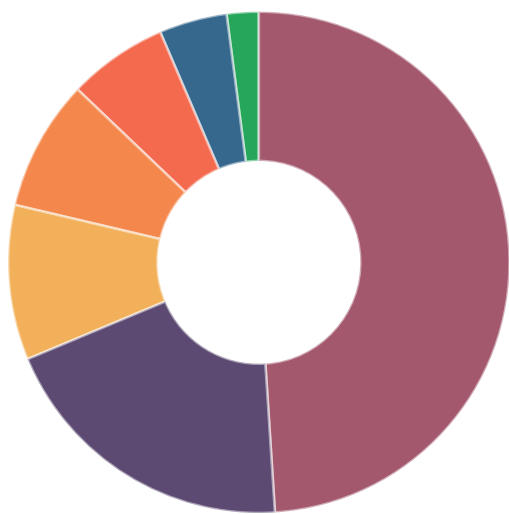

2016 Placement

September 2016 reported 198 students were placed in jobs excluding educational placement of 19



2017 Placement

As of January 2017 it has been reported 223 were placed. Of which 204 were placed in jobs and 19 were enrolled in further educational programs



Conclusion

BMCC's TAACCCT II program had 328 students completing the training program. Of which 223 were placed and 103 remains to be placed.

The Borough of Manhattan Community College TAACCCT II programs demonstrated great success in its ability to train 328 students in medical billing & coding, medical specialist, and electronic health records. Their training and employment retention rate was estimated at 93% which indicates students whom completed the program had a high likelihood of finding employment. Lastly, this program exceed the Department of Labor goal committed goals.
