KMCB 0140 Medical Office Software - Course Description: The student will use medical office software to enter patient information, payment transactions, print statements and reports, create and submit insurance claims, prepare collection letters and reports, and schedule appointments.

Have you ever wanted to work in a medical office as a medical secretary, receptionist, or medical administrative assistant? There is an increasing demand for medical office workers including medical secretaries, medical billing clerks, and medical coders. Understanding how to use medical office software is a crucial component of these jobs. KMCB 0140 Medical Office Software is a course in which you will demonstrate the ability to understand and utilize the administrative and financial functions used in the medical documentation and billing cycle of a practice management program (PMP). For this course, you will be using a practice management program called "Medisoft". There are numerous practice management program software packages on the market that medical offices use, and Medisoft is just one of those programs. Your doctor's office may use a completely different PMP program; however, the basic administrative and financial tasks performed in a medical practice are very similar. If you know the basics of using one PMP software program, you will usually have no trouble quickly learning another program. Learning to use medical office software is fun, interesting, and challenging.

1.01 Medisoft v17 Test 1- Requires Respondus LockDown Browser

Instructions

Medisoft v17 Test 1 is a Multiple Choice test. This test covers the material in Chapter 1 of your textbook.

The test must be taken in the classroom using the Lockdown Browser. Follow these steps to take the test:

1. After completing Chapter 1, open the study guide for Test 1 (located in the Test Study Guides v17 zip file that you downloaded when you started the course) or download the link to the study guide below.

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2. Find the answers to the items on the study guide in your chapter. The test is based on what is in the study guide.

3. In the classroom, get into the Lockdown Browser on the computer. The instructions for using the Lockdown Browser are located on the Home page. Ask your instructor for help, if you don't know what to do.

4. Get into the Lockdown Browser. Your instructor will need to put in a password for the test. **Once you begin the test, you cannot get back out.** If you leave, it will score only what you have done. Make sure you are getting into the correct test before you begin!

Instructions to use LockDown Browser

LockDown Browser - If you are required to use the Lockdown Browser for your test, follow the instructions below:

Note: LockDown Browser is required for some exams. If LockDown Browser is not installed on your computer, tell your instructor.

1. If you are logged into Canvas, log off and close browser window.
2. On the desktop look for the LockDown Browser (a padlock icon) icon. Double-click the icon.
3. On the Choose Server menu, choose Canvas from the dropdown list and click OK.
4. Log into Canvas and select your course.
5. Click on the exam link.
6. Click **Take this exam** link.
7. If a password is required, ask your instructor to put in the password.
8. Read each question and choose the best answer(s).
9. Click the star before the question if you want to come back to it later. The question will be moved to the end of the list.
10. When you have answered all the questions, click the **Submit** button. You will be shown your score. A score of **80%** or better is considered passing.
