

- **How to check your advisor's information:**
 - ROC>SELF SERVICES>STUDENTS>ACADEMIC PROFILE>PROGRAM/ADVISOR INFORMATION
- **When are important deadlines?**
 - Check the academic calendar to ensure you do not miss important deadlines!
 - Contact your academic advisor at the beginning of the semester
 - Check your planner!
 - Contact the Allied Health Admissions Coordinator about program specific dates!

 - **Nursing-Practical Nursing-Fall and Spring start**
 - Fall Priority Deadline- January 31st
 - Spring Priority Deadline- September 1st
 - **Nursing- Advanced Placement- Spring start**
 - Spring Priority Deadline - October 1st
 - **Dental Hygiene- Fall start**
 - Fall Deadline January 31st
 - **Dental Assisting- Fall start**
 - Fall Priority Deadline- January 31st
 - **PTA- Spring start**
 - Spring Priority Deadline- September 1st
 - **Medical Assistant- Fall start**
 - Fall Priority Deadline-2weeks after spring semester begins
 - **Surgical Technology – Fall start**
 - Fall Priority Deadline-2weeks after spring semester begins
- **What is my start term?**
 - Your start term is when you are predicted to be eligible for acceptance into your Allied Health Program of choice.
 - You must meet with your advisor to ensure your start date is correct. If your start date is incorrect it could keep you from being accepted into the Allied Health Program.
- **What informational nights should I be attending?**

 - You will be getting emails sent to your ROC email from not only your academic advisor but the Allied Health Admissions Coordinator within the first couple weeks of class. You will need to be checking your ROC email along with the Allied Health Signature Programs ROC page.
