OPPORTUNITY

Veterans will complete the program with an Advanced Technical Certificate in Practical Nursing and be eligible to sit for the NCLEX-PN exam.

Go to work as a practical nurse or continue toward an associate's degree or bachelor's degree in registered nursing.

ELIGIBILITY

Must be a U.S. Military Veteran with medic or corpsmen training and experience. Experience will be assessed on an individual basis.
