MATH WORKSHOPS

Through our **UP PROGRAM**, NCMC offers week-long math workshops for students who test into developmental math. The goal at the end of the week is to have “brushed UP” their math skills enough to hopefully skip a level of math. A math placement test will be given at the end of the week to determine if they were successful. The objective is to accelerate the student to their degree-required math course faster!

CO-REQUISITE MATH COURSES

Also through the **UP PROGRAM**, NCMC is offering co-requisite math options. Basically, a student will take a math class a level higher than the one they placed into with an additional required workshop that will provide targeted support and personalized assistance. Once again, the idea is to *accelerate* the student to their degree-required math faster! **Students are also required to take **College Seminar** (1 credit hour) if they are enrolled in one of the MoSTEM co-requisite math courses.**

FREE online math tutoring will be available for MoSTEMWIN students **ONLY**. This will allow students to have access to a tutor whenever they need it, not just during campus working hours.

CERTIFIED PRODUCTION TECHNICIAN (CPT) COURSES

Through the CPT program, students will be eligible for **five different individual certifications through the MSSC (Manufacturing Skill Standards Council)**. Areas of study include Safety, Quality Practices & Measurement, Manufacturing Processes & Production, and Maintenance Awareness. Once these four certificates are earned, students may receive the **CPT** certificate.

***A bonus credential - All participants will be required to take the Workkeys test with which they could receive an NCRC, the National Career Readiness Certificate.**

Ways to qualify:

A person must qualify as Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA or Trade Act), Veteran, Unemployed, Underemployed, or Low-skilled (i.e. math placement score into developmental math).
