TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT SPECIALISTS

Training and development specialists help plan, conduct, and administer programs that train employees and improve their skills and knowledge. Design training and development programs to improve individual and organizational performance. May analyze training needs. Training and development specialists organize or deliver training sessions using lectures, group discussions, team exercises, hands-on examples, and other formats. Training can be in the form of a video, self-guided instructional manual, or online application. Training also may be collaborative, which allows employees to connect informally with experts, mentors, and colleagues, often through the use of technology. Training and development specialists may monitor instructors, guide employees through media-based programs, or facilitate informal or collaborative learning programs.

- Assess training needs through surveys, interviews with employees, or consultations with managers or instructors
- Design and create training manuals, online learning modules, and course materials
- Review training materials from a variety of vendors and choose appropriate materials
- Deliver training to employees using a variety of instructional techniques
- Monitor and evaluate training programs to ensure they are current and effective
