- No Criminal Record
- 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Proficiency on the TABE in Reading and Math
- Priority is given to TAA qualified individuals, veterans and/or eligible spouse

- Pharmacy Technician  
20 hours per week for 6 weeks  
Hours: Monday-Thursday  
8:30am-2pm
