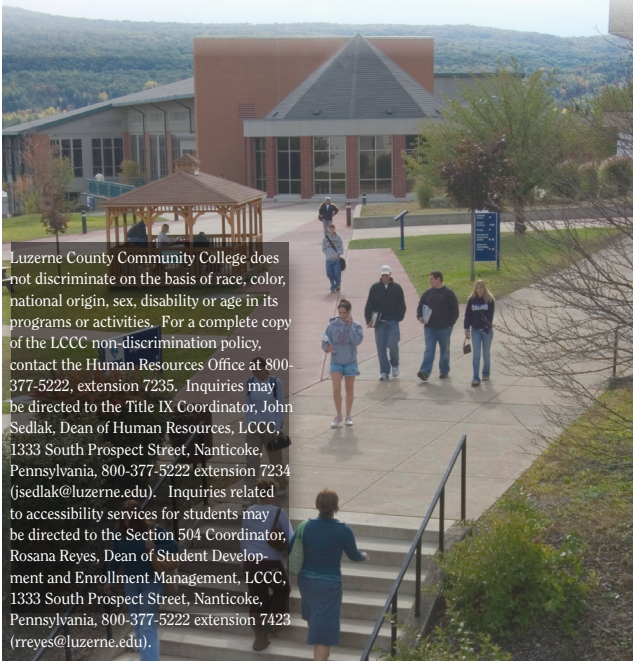

Pennsylvania's Advanced Training & Hiring's (PATH) mission is to provide students with advanced career training and help find placement in the workforce. PATH strives to equip our students with the tools, knowledge, and guidance to obtain successful career placement in a multitude of growing industries.

Employers will be involved in a variety of ways: input in curriculum development, apprenticeships and internship opportunities, mentorship, and donating or loaning equipment. Industry partners may have employees who could benefit from additional training, and giving hiring priority to students who complete the programs.

DIESEL TRUCK TECHNOLOGY

The Diesel Truck Technology certificate provides training for apprenticeship-level preventive maintenance technician in the diesel service industry.

ENGINEERING DESIGN AND MANUFACTURING

The Engineering Design and Manufacturing A.A.S. degree trains students as draftspersons, designers, manufacturing technicians or engineering technologists. Students may also continue their studies leading to an advanced degree at a four-year institution in Manufacturing or Design Technology.

WELDING

The Welding diploma provides training for beginners, as well as and enhanced skill development for experienced welders.
