I. Scope of the Program

Boilermakers & Welding Institute and Arkansas State University Mid-South (ASU Mid-South) hereby establish an articulation agreement leading to articulated coursework required for the certificates of proficiency in the following: Gas Metal Arc Welding, Gas Tungsten Arc Welding, Flux-Core Arc Welding and Shielded Metal Arc Welding. These credentials will be conferred by Boilermakers & Welding Institute.

II. Length of Agreement

The agreement will begin Fall semester 2017. The parties commit to an annual review beginning the summer semester 2018 for the next two years. At that time, reviews will take place every other year.

III. Course Articulation

Students completing NCCER Core Curriculum, Welding Level I, and Level II (*BWI Welding Professional Program*) at ASU Mid-South will be granted entry into Boilermakers & Welding Institute's *Welding Specialist Program* (NCCER LEVEL III AND IV). Students must provide evidence of completion of NCCER Core Curriculum, Level I and/or II Certification by Portfolio Application. Students will be required to provide either a NCCER certificate or certification card as evidence of successful completion as the Portfolio Application. (See Appendix A)

IV. Tuition and Fees

Tuition will be billed to each student at Boilermaker & Welding Institute's rate for ASU Mid-South students.
