The Annual Refresher Course is an 8-hour course and fulfills MSHA's Part 46 annual training requirement for anyone engaged in shell dredging or employed at sand, gravel, surface stone, surface clay, colloidal phosphate, or surface limestone mines, or persons, partnerships, corporations, subsidiaries of a corporation, firms, associations, or other organizations that contract to perform services at any of the above listed sites.

Upon completion of the course, students will receive an MSHA Form 5000-23 certifying that they have completed 8 hours of annual refresher training.
