Title: MSHA Part 48 – Annual Refresher Training

Project/Course Description:

The Annual Refresher Course is an 8-hour course and fulfills MSHA's Part 48 annual training requirement for anyone working at either a coal, metal, certain surface nonmetal mine or all underground mines.

Upon completion of the course, students will receive an MSHA Form 5000-23 certifying that they have completed 8 hours of annual refresher training. This course is intended for those individuals working in the mining industry.
