Project/Course Description:

This course is designed for general industry workers covered by OSHA 29 CFR 1910 that need to receive additional training, when required by OSHA standards, on specific hazards of the job. This program is designed to meet the needs of industry workers to stay in compliance. This course is intended for supervisors with some safety responsibility. Training should emphasize hazard identification, avoidance, control and prevention.

- Managing Safety and Health
- Walking & Working Surfaces
- Emergency Action Plan
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Electrical Safety
- Hazard Communication/Right to Know
- Material Handling
