Montana HealthCARE project

The Montana HealthCARE project used the following strategies to address the gap between the state's educational capacity and healthcare employers' demands: (1) Create statewide healthcare pathways characterized by stacked and latticed credentials and contextualized curricula; (2) Address Montana's nursing shortages by providing accelerated pathways to credential completion; (3) Increase success for students by providing services that better prepare adult learners for college; accelerate credential completion; coach students in pathway navigation; and provide access to distance education, and (4) Engage the healthcare industry, education, workforce programs, and other stakeholders in healthcare workforce transformation; on-the-job and apprenticeship opportunities; rapid response cycle regional planning; and data driven approaches.

Welcome to the Healthcare Apprenticeship Implementation Toolkit! Montana grew apprenticeships in healthcare from 0 to 60 in three years. Well more specifically, zero to two hundred apprentices, 50 employer sponsors, and 17 different occupations! Here, you'll find the tools that we created to promote, customize, and implement healthcare apprenticeship programs. The materials start with general information. Next, you'll find tools we developed to explain apprenticeship to our partners. They are tailored to employers, campus faculty, and workforce partners. Next, you'll find materials specific to each occupation in which we have apprenticeship programs. This includes the trade schedule that outlines on the job training competencies and related curriculum, as well as other items we use to explain or implement programs in that occupation. Finally, you'll see apprenticeship registration documents. 3. Community management services to enable Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) to reliably evaluate and share quality workforce development materials.

Why Go through the Curation Process?

Human Resources staff and other human capital talent developers need efficient and reliable methods to select quality training materials required to enhance the skills of prospective and current employees. An effectively curated collection of training materials will:

1. Enable workforce trainers and faculty to design and deliver high-quality courses.
2. Provide a faster and cheaper approach to creating customized curricula for use by industry, workforce development boards and higher education.
3. Assist in keeping pace with training requirements of frequently changing workforce programs.
