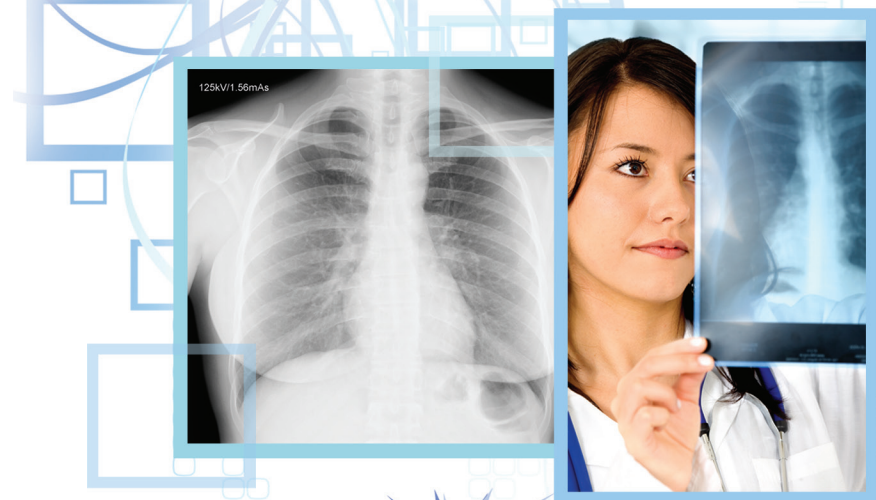

- Complete WorkKeys assessment at Career Center by 2/01/13
- If Eligible, continue to Admissions Section. (This does not guarantee acceptance into the training program.)

ADMISSIONS

- Take COMPASS test at Jefferson College's Testing Center & meet with advisor to review scores

ACCEPTANCE
