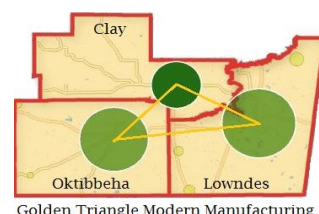


East Mississippi Community College Golden Triangle Modern Manufacturing Project

Modern Manufacturing Sector Advisory Council Strategic Plan

GOAL 1: Provide regular input to EMCC to improve manufacturing training to meet industry needs in the Golden Triangle Region.

STRATEGY 1: Support EMCC's move to create a new Manufacturing Technology and Engineering Division (MTED) that combines manufacturing related Career and Technical Education credit training programs with non-credit skill training programs into one administrative unit that can share resources and instructors.

STRATEGY 2: Help EMCC identify important manufacturing skills that can be validated by industry-recognized credential assessments and embed those assessments into MTED programs.

STRATEGY 3: Help EMCC identify areas of weakness in programs and find solutions to correct such weaknesses.

STRATEGY 4: Help EMCC expand its work-based learning and paid internship program.

GOAL 2: Help EMCC build capacity to strengthen manufacturing training in the Golden Triangle Region.

STRATEGY 1: Help provide resources and equipment for EMCC to expand and add manufacturing training capacity.

STRATEGY 2: Support EMCC's plan to add three craft technician programs to its MTED offerings.

STRATEGY 3: Help EMCC recruit students into manufacturing programs.
