- **Introduction:** Focuses on what you will be learning
- **Focusing your Learning:** *Objectives and what you will be learning*
- Presentation and Practice: Provides information and practice activities that cover the topics you will learn
- **Summarize and Review:** Wraps up what you have learned
- Assessing your Learning: Assignments you will complete to see how much you have learned
