

**Exercise 2:**  
**Installation and Routing Practice**

In this exercise students demonstrate their ability to install cables on routing boards, with techniques such as Fiber Protection, Slack, and Drip Loops.

	1. Obtain the drawing and all of the supplies that you need to route the cable assembly on the board.
	2. Install the receptacle.
	3. Route the assembly on the board.
	4. Attach ties as needed.
	5. Attach the assemblies to the supports.
	6. <b>Do Not</b> mate the connectors.
	7. When complete, ask your instructor to check your work and record the results on your checklist.
