Sequencing of Course Content	1	Course outline lists topics to be covered in a logical order.	
Opportunities for Active Learning	1	Group activities, video discussion, and lab exercises and projects are listed under learning activities. However, only one lab is provided.	
Opportunities for Formative Feedback to Students	1	It is assumed lab tests would provide opportunities for formative feedback. One lab test is included in the materials. Course syllabus states that class assignments and tests account for 40% of grade and these would provide opportunity for feedback, although these are not provided.	
Summative Assessment of Learning	1	Classroom tests are cited in the syllabus, but are not provided. Although there is no final exam mentioned, students take the AWS Sense Level 1 GTAW Principles exam at the beginning and completion of the course. The syllabus states this does not cover the course in its entirety but provides a good baseline for student progress.
