We spend so much time on theory of EHR and excess time on learning computer skills, even if you already had them, it was disappointing. I surely could have tested out of the computer class, since we went at a primary pace for the unskilled students. It would have been better to split the student by ability. The computer course was required whether you could do it or not, and so the weeks we spent doing that were also weeks not learning coding or billing. ☐

I am very disappointed that the main importation information, BILLING AND CODING was smashed into a few weeks with 8 hour days. This cram was not helpful and did not guarantee readiness for the 7 hour test for certification. it consisted of teachers reading power point slides to the class, and at a 8 hours a day, not a great for learning. We as a class did study groups and played games and made flash cards on our own, if it was not for the comradery of the class the whole six months would be a total regret. I arranged many of those study groups to help us learn the material, but it was not enough time and we were consumed with long days of dull education.☐

We spent 6 months in the program and a only a few weeks on the actual coding. I signed on because I was promised I could get a good job making 50k or more a year. In reality there was very little on the job, real world training, and no internships, or externships, or company partnerships, to filter graduating students into. I am currently working at a Mental Health Facility in transportation, driving vans, and making the schedules for \$14.00 an hour full time.☐

I would have been better off taking an actual credited course that would mean something to an employer. I feel the 20 million dollar grant awarded to BCCC was used to benefit BCCC more than the students, and not for lack of passion, but for lack of leadership, The organization let the instructors determine the schedules, and disregarded the cost to students to get to and from the college for half days 5 days a week for a month or more instead of longer steady days to get the work done and finished. The constantly changing schedule (days varied) interfered with part time, very necessary, jobs,for people who were barely surviving. The class schedule was so varied in the six month plan that it was impossible to keep a part time job for some students. They should have had a regular schedule with coding and billing all along, and then have afternoon sessions for those students needing computer skills, or resume
