Conclusion / 20	Conclusion creatively summarizes claims made throughout the paper, adequately reflects thesis, and includes no new information. Conclusion does not adequately summarize points made in the paper, may not have points to summarize	Conclusion has new information, does little to <i>conclude</i> the essay.	No conclusion
Grammar & Style / 10	Paper follows basic requirements in form, has creative word and sentence structure, has zero grammatical errors	Paper follows basic requirements in form, has good word and sentence structure, has only a few grammatical errors	Paper formatted incorrectly, and/or questionable word choice, noncreative sentence structure; several grammatical errors	Paper formatted incorrectly; words are often used incorrectly; Grammatical errors detract from the goals of the paper	Paper does not at all follow the basic requirements in form, and words are often used incorrectly; constant grammatical errors make the paper extremely difficult to understand
