#### **BASIC COMPUTERS IN HEALTHCARE** (47-501-401-0001)

Learn the benefits of the electronic health record (EHR) and how it can be applied directly to the healthcare workplace. Guided hands-on experience will develop an understanding of computerized medical records.
