Online, self-paced training through Tooling U-SME

(12 weeks, up to 400 classes)

Greenfield Community College has partnered with ToolingU-SME to offer an interactive, online training program with industry-driven curriculum that aligns to national credentials, including NIMS, MSSC, SME.

Students will have unlimited access for **120 days** to support ongoing, self-paced knowledge retention through their ToolingU.COM subscription using a unique username and password to learn occupational skills designed for manufacturers using text, audio voiceovers, video, photographs and illustrations.

All courses include a class outline, class objectives, a vocabulary list, pre-test and final exam, an interactive dictionary and note-taking capabilities. Students can take participate in as many on-line classes as possible during the duration of the program and are encouraged to take classes towards specific manufacturing certificates in order to become ready for the workforce.
