This program prepares students to become an important member of a caregiving team that assists the elderly and those with disabilities with their daily living activities. A Home Care Aide works in private residences, residential complexes, hospitals, and adult daycare facilities. The personal care provided by a home care aide requires an individual to be sensitive to the needs of clients and their circumstances. They help clients with many daily living activities from basic hygiene, dressing and preparing meals to general housekeeping and occasional transportation assistance.

Like many other states, Nevada continues to experience shortages in the healthcare workforce. Students completing this program receive the training and skills needed in this critical and emerging healthcare field. A career as a home care aide allows for flexible work schedules and the opportunity for career expansion.

## Course Information

Students are required to take 120 hours of coursework over a five-week term that includes lecture and skills lab. Communication skills and the understanding of individual client needs are assessed.
