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Course Description

This course is designed to prepare the student to work as a home care aide, to competently assist elderly and disabled adults with activities of daily living. Communication skills and the understanding of individual client needs are stressed.

Training and Lab time place emphasis on:

- ◆ Safety
- ◆ Client Rights
- ◆ Effects of aging
- ◆ Common disease processes
- ◆ Caregiver Etiquette
- ◆ Infection Control Procedures
- ◆ Nutrition
- ◆ Mental Health

Basic skills are integrated into the classroom teaching format, giving students support in comprehension of content. Tutors are available in the Studio Lab to assist in GED preparation, improving academic and work skills to enter the job market or continuing educational programs.

Admissions Requirements

- ◆ Not have committed a felony/misdemeanor within the past seven years.
- ◆ 18 years of age or older.
- ◆ Show proof of a negative drug test prior to the first day of class.
- ◆ Show proof of a negative 2-Step TB Skin test.
- ◆ Students are required to show proof of completion of a physical examination. (Physical check sheet will be supplied).
