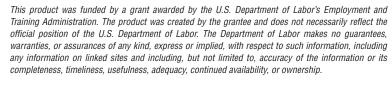

Microsoft Technology Associate - Infrastructure Course

In this course, students are introduced to the fundamental concepts of Windows networking as required for the Microsoft Technical Associate Certification. Four knowledge domains comprise this course: Networking Fundamentals, Security Fundamentals, Operating System Fundamentals, and Windows Server Fundamentals.

Exam Prep CNT 100 – Introduction to Windows Networking (4 credits)

Module 1 – Windows Operating System Fundamentals

Understanding operating system configurations, installing and upgrading client systems, managing applications, managing files and folders, managing devices and understanding operating system maintenance. Preparation for exam 349.

Module 2 – Windows Server Administration Fundamentals

Understanding server installation, server roles, active directory, server storage, server performance management and server maintenance. Preparation for exam 365.

Module 3 – Networking Fundamentals

Understanding network infrastructures, network hardware and protocols and services. Preparation for exam 366.

Module 4 – Security Fundamentals

Understanding security layers, operating system security, network security, and security software. Preparation for exam 367.
