FastPath. Your Road to Job-Ready.



FastPath is a program that helps Columbus residents gain the job skills for entry-level employment in one of four growing fields:

- Patient Care (STNA certification)
- Building Services (OSHA certification)
- Food Services (ServSafe™ certification)
- Logistics (Certified Logistics Associate certification)

In the FastPath program, you will learn:

- Entry level skills for your chosen field
- Basic computer literacy
- Customer service
- Organization
- Time management
- Work success skills
- Financial literacy

In addition, we will guide you through the steps to help you get a job, including:

- Résumé writing
- Interview preparation
- Job application support

Eligible Candidates

To be eligible for FastPath, you must:

- Be a resident of the City of Columbus
- Be at least 18 years old
- Have a high school diploma or GED* and score at least at the 9th-grade proficiency level on a standardized placement test
- Pass a criminal background check and drug screen
- Be eligible to work in the U.S.
- Be recommended through a workforce partner (see back of brochure)

IMPORTANT: Candidates must meet ALL criteria to be accepted into the FastPath program.
