The course description also speaks to Lock out Tag out as do the course outcomes. However, there is no mention of lock-out tag out in the course calendar. This must be corrected. If the item is included in both the course description and outcomes, it must also be included in the calendar.
Description of assessments, evaluation, exams and grading process	Partial	Syllabus speaks to tests, point values and percentages to outline the grading process. Other than naming the exams, there is no explanation of assessment types, etc.
