Albany Technical College **Turner Job Corps** COURSE ARTICULATION AGREEMENT August 11, 2015

Albany Technical College and Turner Job Corps agree as follows:

Purpose:

The two institutions are entering into a course Articulation Agreement in support of Complete College Georgia to assist and promote Prior Learning Assessment in the transferability of the Turner Job Corps Training Achievement Record (TAR) to the associated Diploma or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree.

Term:

Terms of this Agreement will be effective July 1, 2015. Regular review of said agreement, at intervals to be set by the two institutions, and in no case less frequently than every three years, will be required. If termination of the agreement is warranted, either party may invoke it with a written one-year notice.

Conditions:

The competencies identified in each Turner Job Corps TAR (exhibits A-G) can be articulated into credit hours for the corresponding ATC Diploma/AAS programs of study, as described in the Agreement on Course Articulation Supplement. All agreements may be subject to a face to face interview and/or skill demonstration evaluated by ATC faculty of the desired subject matter area.

Acceptability of articulated credit is dependent upon students" completion of the Turner Job Corps program with an appropriate rating of either a 2 - Proficient, or 3 -Proficient and can teach others, as identified in the Agreement on Course Articulation Supplement. The Supplement and Attachments are part of this agreement and are incorporated by reference.

Articulated credit cannot exceed 75% of credit hours required for graduation.

Agreement on Communication, Student Transition and Accreditation:

Albany Technical College and Turner Job Corps agree to cooperate in communicating with each other and with their publics concerning the articulation relationship between the two institutions.

At least one administrative or faculty member will be appointed from each participating college/Institution to act as primary point of contact and agent for this agreement, to speak for the institution and to communicate details and modifications to respective faculty, advisors and others with interest at the individual institutions.

Both parties agree to extend their best efforts to ensure that the transition from Turner Job Corps to Albany Technical College will be a smooth process for the students who choose to take advantage of the said agreement.

Notification of substantive changes to courses and programs, such as changes of content, learning outcomes, credit, or termination, made by one institution to the courses covered by this agreement will be given to the other institution and will result in a review for impact on the agreement.

This agreement is made contingent on both parties maintaining all applicable program and institution accreditations, including both SACSCOC/COE and appropriate professional bodies. Both institutions agree to provide whatever data is needed by the other institution to support accreditation requirements.
