What is open?

Open = resources that are shared with permission to retain, reuse, revise, remix AND redistribute (5Rs)

Resources include:

- Software (Opensource)
- Platforms
- Systems (Open Systems>transparency)
- Data (Open Data)
- Open Content (Open Educational Resources; Open Textbooks, Open Courseware, among others)
- Our OER resources

Getting started with Open

- Don't re-invent the wheel adapt content
- When writing or updating curriculum, consider open resources
- Partner with other faculty to evaluate or create content
- Get students involved OER as classwork
